Wednesday, we read about the life cycle of a pumpkin and practiced putting numbers in order with pumpkins. Thursday, we read The Shy Scarecrow, learned a song about scarecrows, and colored scarecrows to practice reading color words. We also made scarecrows with our 6th grade buddies. Friday, we read books about Fall or Autumn and worked in our "Four Seasons Science Journal".

We worked at number stations most of the week. We are concentrating on recognizing and writing numbers 0-5. We also organized the pumpkin patch by putting pumpkins in order from 1-10. As we have been assessing for first quarter conferences, we are noticing that some of the "K" Kids need to practice number recognition and counting up to 25. Friday, we graphed our favorite season.
