Math

While learning about Presidents, we started talking about money. Our kindergarten objective is to identify the penny, nickel, dime, and quarter and know the value of each. We also started working on number stations during our math time. Each child is building with five objects. We then record, or copy, what we made. Soon we will be writing equations ($2+3=5$) etc. Kindergarten students aren't expected to memorize any addition/subtraction facts, but to understand that there are several combinations to make the number 5. As individual students demonstrate proficiency with the number five, they will be moving on to higher numbers at their own pace.
