We did several math activities this week with our apples. We practiced using the balance scale and talked about the words 'heavier' and 'lighter'. Most people use rulers or inches to measure length, but we used apples! We found that the "K" Kids are about 15 apples tall. We also estimated the number of apple prints that it would take to go around a large paper apple. It was interesting to compare all of the different colors and kinds of apples. After comparing them, we graphed our favorite color of apple. Ask your favorite "K" Kid which color had the most.
